1. Initial Planning

- □ Decide on a beach location

- □ Decide on color palette

- Create a message in a bottle guestbook
- □ Prepare wedding favors (custom flip-flops, sunglasses, etc.)

- Confirm local rules (bonfires, alcohol, etc.) Arrange cleanup
